1. Go to the City of Imperial Beach Citizen Self-Service Portal Registration (<https://imperialbeachca-energovpub.tylerhost.net/Apps/SelfService#/register>)
2. Enter your desired email (any future submittals/applications will be linked to this email).
Complete Steps 1 – 4 on the website
 - a. after entering your desired email address, you will be asked to confirm via email.

- b. Click confirm and you will be asked to create a username and password.

 - Enter city, state, zip, county, and address type as applicable.
- e. Click submit, and this will create your citizen self-service account.

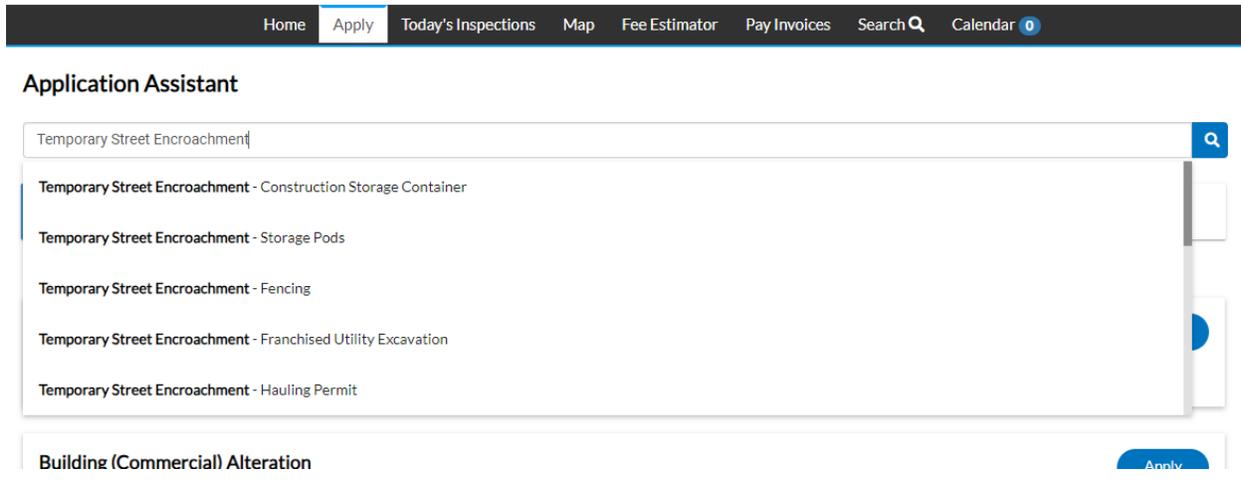
APPLY FOR AN ENCROACHMENT PERMIT

1. On the home screen click on “apply” and a list of permits will appear. Click “All” to expand additional permit types.

- Please note that all encroachment permits require a site plan to be attached to the application. Your site plan must include the components outlined in this [plot plan handout](#) and must be drawn to scale.
