## AFFIDAVIT OF SMOKE ALARM AND CARBON MONOXIDE ALARM INSTALLATION

When the valuation of additions, alterations or repairs to dwelling units exceed \$1,000 (CRC R314.8.2), State law requires verification of proper installation of smoke and carbon monoxide alarms whenever a building permit is obtained for one- and two-family dwellings and townhouses not more than three stories above grade. This form enables a property owner or licensed contractor to self-certify that requirements for these alarms have been met when the building permit is for a project that does not require a building inspector to enter the dwelling to conduct a final inspection. Examples of such projects are reroof projects, solar installations, water heater replacements in a garage, and other similar minor improvements that do not require an interior inspection by a building inspector.

### ALARM REQUIREMENTS

- Smoke and combination smoke and carbon monoxide alarms shall be listed in accordance with UL217 and / or UL2034
- Systems and components shall be listed and approved by the State Fire Marshal
- The devices shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation instructions

Complete and sign this affidavit prior to requesting a final inspection for your project. Failure to have this form completed at the time of inspection will result in your project not being approved.
