CLASS INFORMATION

Sessions

These classes run on a seasonal eight-week session. Registration opens two weeks before the class start date and continues through the first two weeks of the session.

Quarterly

These classes run quarterly. Registration opens two weeks before the quarter start date and continues until the end of the quarterly period.

Monthly

These classes run monthly. Registration opens two weeks before the class start date and continues through the first week of the month.

Daily

These classes are open for registration the day of the class.

RESIDENT & NON-RESIDENT RATES


Imperial Beach residents qualify for a resident rate for most programs, classes, park rentals, and activities. Proof of residency may be required. Addresses that are outside of the incorporated city limits do not qualify for the resident rate. Resident and non-resident rates may be listed in the guide as (R) and (NR).

WAITING LIST

In the event that a class is full, a patron may be added to the class/program waiting list. There is a 24-hour return contact policy for all wait lists. If the patron is contacted via email/phone and does not respond within 24 hours, the space in the class will be made available to the next person on the waiting list. It is the responsibility of the patron to make sure account contact information is accurate. Emails/calls will be made in waitlist order.
