A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTYWIDE  
REDEVELOPMENT SUCCESSOR AGENCY OVERSIGHT BOARD  
APPROVING THE RECOGNIZED OBLIGATION PAYMENT  
SCHEDULE AND ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET FOR THE IMPERIAL  
BEACH REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY SUCCESSOR AGENCY FOR  
THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2022 - JUNE 30, 2023

WHEREAS, the Imperial Beach Redevelopment Agency Successor Agency prepared the recognized obligation payment schedule for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 (ROPS 22-23) pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34177(i); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34171(h), the recognized obligation payment schedule lists the minimum amounts and due dates of payments to be made by the Successor Agency as required by enforceable obligations during the twelve-month period covered by the recognized obligation payment schedule; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34177(o), the ROPS 22-23 must be approved by the San Diego Countywide Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board and submitted to the State Department of Finance and County Auditor-Controller no later than February 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Imperial Beach Redevelopment Agency Successor Agency prepared the proposed administrative budget for July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34177(j); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 34177(j), the Imperial Beach Redevelopment Agency Successor Agency submitted the proposed administrative budget to the Oversight Board for its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the ROPS 22-23 is approved.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the approved ROPS 22-23 shall be submitted to the State Department of Finance and County Auditor-Controller no later than February 1, 2022.
